Patient Rated Wrist Evaluation Description total PRWE score, where 0 is the best score (no pain or difficulty performing activities) and 100 is the worse score (severe continuous pain and unable to perform activities) (MacDermid 2007) Reliability and validity: The test-retest reliability of the PRWE is high (ICC > 0.90) over the short and long

Background The Patient-rated Wrist Evaluation (PRWE) is a commonly used instrument in upper extremity surgery and in research However, to recognize a treatment effect expressed as a change in PRWE, it is important to be aware of the minimum clinically important difference (MCID) and the minimum detectable change (MDC) The MCID of
